CASCADE HERITAGE POWER PROJECT RECEIVES EXTENSION

Sea Breeze Power Corp. (“the Company”) is pleased to announce that the Cascade Heritage Power Project has been granted a five-year extension to its Environmental Assessment Certificate by the BC Environmental Assessment Office.

The Cascade Heritage Power Project, a 28 MW “run-of-river” hydroelectric development project, is located at the historic site of the Cascade Power Dam on the Kettle River close to Christina Lake in southeast BC. The Cascade Heritage Power Project is designed to generate clean, sustainable power each year – enough to meet the electricity needs of approximately 10,000 homes on an annual basis.

In other corporate news, the Company is also pleased to advise that the Company’s Common Shares were reinstated for trading on the TSX Venture Exchange on Friday, August 12, 2011.

Sea Breeze Power Corp. is a Vancouver-based renewable energy company focused on unlocking British Columbia’s enormous by ‘stranded’ renewable energy potential.
